Roy Moore led the fight to **keep school** **segregation** in our state Constitution.

As recently as 2004 he was fighting to keep racism the law in Alabama.

Instead of working to move Alabama forward, Moore led the campaign against removing racist, outdated language from our state Constitution that required segregation in Alabama schools.¹

And Moore has ties to hate groups like the KKK.

Roy Moore has repeatedly worked alongside racists and white supremacists who support his agenda. A Mississippi KKK group supported Moore's refusal to enforce federal law,² and Moore's legal foundation accepted a thousand-dollar contribution from a Neo-Nazi group.³
